



Hello Sunday school families,

We are excited to announce that we will be resuming in-person Sunday school on May 2nd! It has been a long time since we have been able to gather for Sunday school, and we are looking forward to welcoming our students back.

To ensure that Sunday school happens safely and successfully, our departments will have the following structures in place:

- Sunday school will run from 9:45-10:20 a.m. for all departments. Students should be dropped off at their departments and remain there for the duration of the time.
- For Beginner students who need a guardian with them during Sunday school, we ask that only one adult accompany per family due to the limited space available.
- Sunday school will be held as a whole group in each department. For now, there will not be individual classes in the departments due to spacing requirements.
- Teaching staff within the departments will wear face coverings, with the possible exception of those who are actively leading a lesson/activity at the front of the room while properly distanced from the students.
- It is recommended that students also wear face coverings during Sunday school time.
- Hand sanitizing stations and extra masks will be available at the entrance of each department.
- Student seating will be spread out in the departments to ensure safe distancing.
- A small, pre-packaged snack will be given to students on the way out of the department each week.
- For now, Sunday school vans will not be sent out. We hope to change that in time.
- Students who have “graduated” to a different department since we last had in-person Sunday school should attend the department that best suits their needs now. As a reminder, the Beginners Department is age two through Kindergarten, the Primary Department is 1st-4th grades, and the Junior Department is 5th-8th grades.

Although things will operate a little differently for now, we can still all come to Sunday school and learn about God’s love and grow in Jesus! We are excited to welcome everyone back soon.
