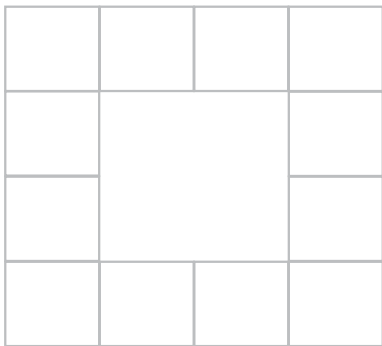

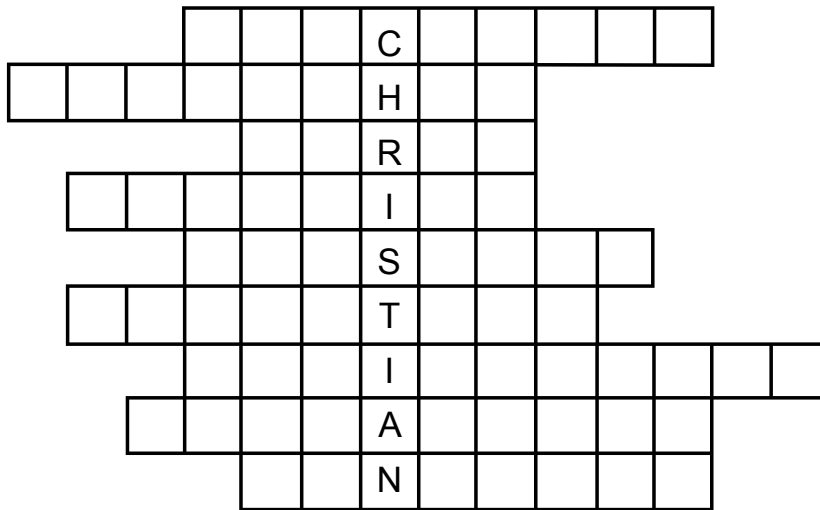

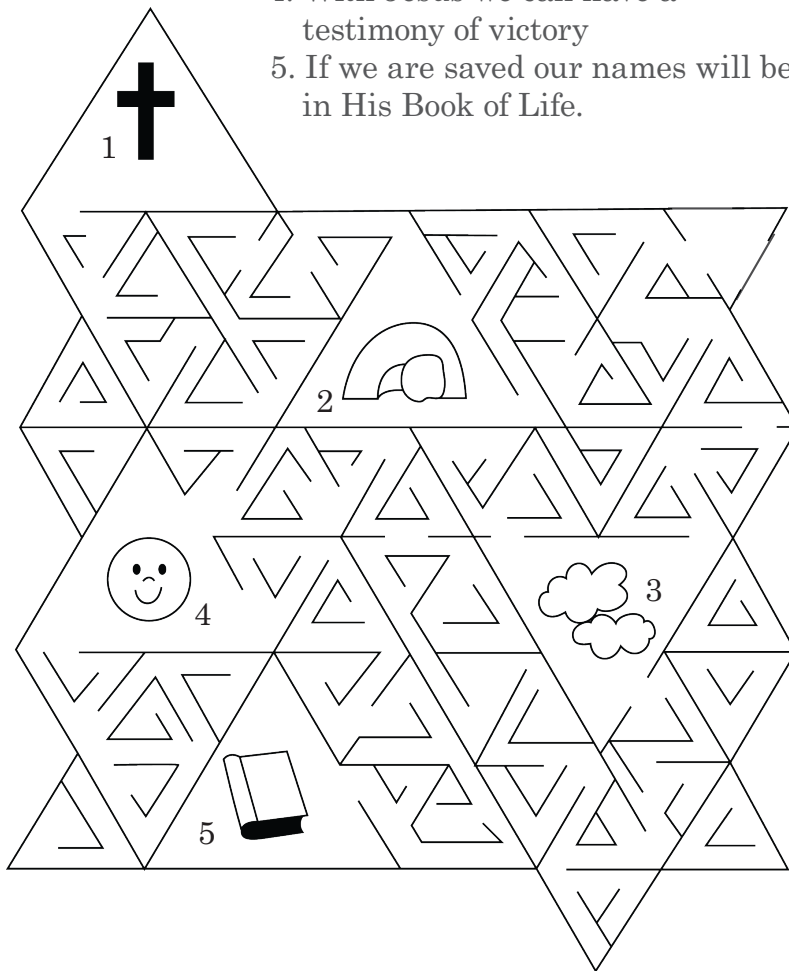

Hidden in the pictures below are the names of some people from this quarter's lessons. How many of them can you unscramble? The Bible reference with each picture will give you a clue.

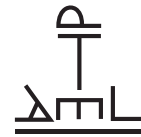

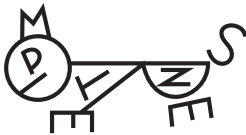
