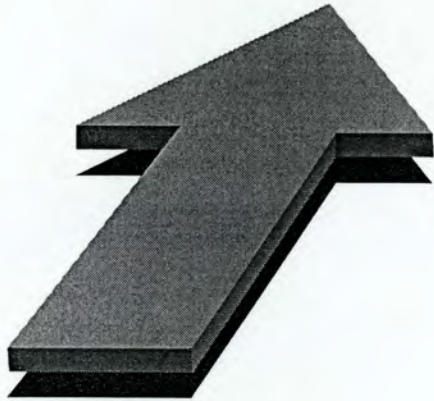

Assign one point for the easiest questions, five points for the hardest. Fourth - Sixth grade level.

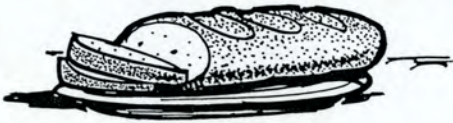

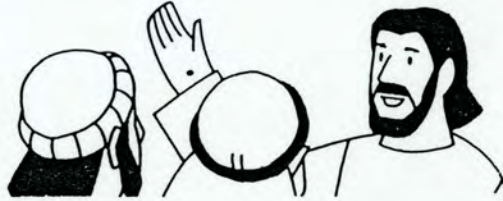
