Title: THE MARRIAGE SUPPER Key Verse: Rev 19:9 Date: _____

Text/Story: Rev 19:7-9; Matt 22:1-14; Luke 12:335-38

Main idea: Those who are raptured will be with Jesus at the Marriage Supper of the Lamb where rewards will be given for faithful service and Jesus Himself will serve those present.

	Pre-Lesson Brainstorm Discussion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> As a class discuss what a wedding involves Brainstorm on the different activities that goes on: preparation, invitations, clothing, reception etc. Show wedding pictures, invitations, gowns, etc. to encourage discussion Write down key words on board
	Lesson: Parable of the Wedding Supper	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tell the story of the Wedding Supper in Matt 22:1-14 using flannelgraph, pictures, etc. or have the students act out (pantomime) as you read the story Explain how the parable is parallel to the real event of the Marriage Supper of the Lamb
	Post-Lesson: Worksheet	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have the students do the worksheet: fill in the blank Go over the answers as a class when completed

Have your students write a "Ten Sentence Story" about the Marriage Supper. The first sentence should have ten words, the next nine, then eight, etc.

Assign each student one word (or more if necessary) from the key verse. Give the a 5" by 7" piece of paper and some markers, and tell them to write their word in fancy letters and color it as they wish. String a piece of heave twine or lightweight rope from one corner of your room to another. Have a good supply of clothespins on your table. When the words are completed, have the students hang up their words in the correct order, to spell out the key verse. Leave it up during your class session.
