Text/Story: Rev. 5:1-14; John 1:29

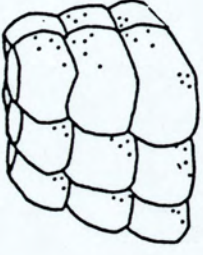
Main idea: Jesus is our sacrificial lamb of Calvary and He alone is worthy to unloose the seals.

Time	Activity	Description
	Pre-Lesson  Question Bowl	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Review information about who Jesus is</li> <li>• Write questions about Jesus' ministry and life on earth on slips of paper (make sure questions are at the level of students in class) e.g., where was Jesus born, how old was he when he questioned doctors at the temple, etc.</li> <li>• Place slips of paper in a large bowl or jar</li> <li>• Divide the class into teams and each team will take turns drawing a question from the bowl and answer as a group</li> <li>• Provide correct answers.</li> </ul>
	Lesson:  Story map	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read the text, Rev 5:1-14 as a class or in partners/groups</li> <li>• Have the students decide what the problem, the outcome and solution are concerning the book sealed with seven seals</li> <li>• Help students write sentences for each part</li> <li>• Emphasize that Jesus as the Sacrificial Lamb is the only one who is worthy</li> </ul>
	Post Lesson  Sword Drill	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Divide the class into two teams</li> <li>• Give out Bible verses on the names of Jesus one at a time and see which team is able to find the verse and give you the name first</li> </ul>

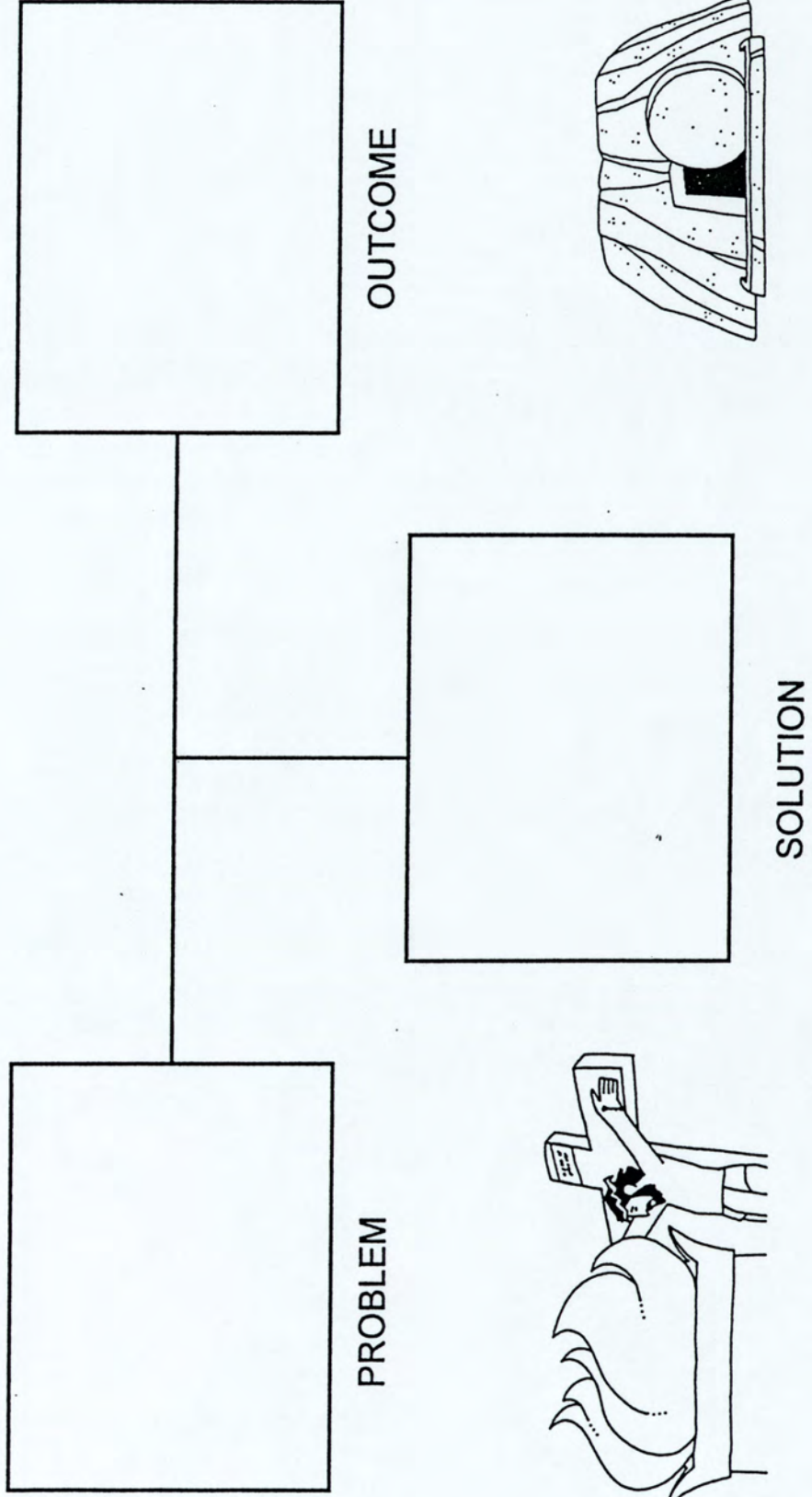


## WORTHY IS THE LAMB

Revelation 5:1-14; John 1:29



Read Revelation 5:1-14 with a partner or a group. Decide what the problem at this point in prophecy is (why did John weep?). Write a sentence to describe it in the first box. In the 'outcome' box, write down the result of the problem (who was found to be worthy to open the seals of the book?). In the 'solution' box, tell how the problem was solved (why was Jesus worthy to unseal the book?)

**WORTHY IS THE LAMB** Additional Activities

Have your students write a Cinquain Poem describing their feelings about the Lamb of God. Have them letter the poems neatly, so they can be posted on a bulletin board. Here is the format for a Cinquain:

Line 1: One word telling the subject of the poem.

Line 2: Two words describing the subject.

Line 3: Three words telling about the subject, ending with "ing."

Line 4: Two or three words telling how you feel about the subject.

Line 5: Another name for the subject.
